It was fantastic to see Class 2 using clay with Mrs Watchorn last week. The designs looked great and I'm looking forward to seeing the finished plates.

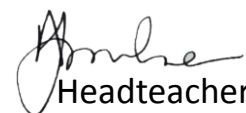


Sports Day
