

HOMEWORK

Doodle Learning – your child's login is in their Reading Record. There is an individual App for each part.
Doodle Maths – a new task will be set each week.
Doodle Spell – Spellings will be set on this every week.
Doodle Times Tables – Occasionally activities will be set on here, do check in.
Doodle English – Occasionally activities will be set on here, do check in.

Homework Folders – These will be handed out on a Monday with a maths worksheet (occasionally other homework) in. They need to be returned by the following Monday.
Spellings – Words will be stuck in Reading Records on a Monday (and assigned on Doodle Spell).
Children need to practise throughout the week. A spelling test is done on a Monday.

DAYS TO REMEMBER

PE – Monday and Friday

Your child should have both school shoes and trainers in school on PE days to help keep our school clean.

Outdoor Learning – Every third **Wednesday**
Your child should have wellies and a warm coat, particularly when the weather is colder.

READING

Children need to record all their reading in their reading records, AT LEAST 3 times a week. Reading records need to be in school every day. Children in Owls Class have the responsibility of changing their book themselves.

Reading bands will be assessed based upon the individual child and their progress.

ASSESSMENT

Year 4 - will have their Multiplication Tables Check (MTC). This is a national assessment that takes place in June. Children will answer 25 questions online. They have 6 seconds to answer each question.
Children are encouraged to engage with Doodle Times Tables to help embed this learning. Maths Frame or timestable.co.uk are good websites for children to practise the MTC.

All children are also assessed in Spellings, Grammar, Maths and Reading 3 times a year.
