

HOMWORK

Online learning is set on **Doodle** platforms. You should download Doodle Maths, Spell, Times Tables and English. Doodle homework activities are set on a Monday and should be completed within the week. Each child's account is a paid for service, so please engage with this to support your child with learning suited specifically to their attainment level.

Year 1 spellings are set on a **Monday**, and the test is the following Monday. Please practise spellings 5 times a week, as this will support your child with reading and independent writing.

Phonics homework for all of Robins will come out on **Fridays** in their clear wallets. This needs to come back every Friday ready for the new sounds that have been learnt that week.

DAYS TO REMEMBER

PE – Monday and Friday

Your child should have both school shoes and trainers in school on PE days to help keep our school clean.

Outdoor Learning – Every third Wednesday

Your child should have wellies and a warm coat, particularly when the weather is colder.

READING

Reading Records should be in school **daily** as we will read with children at any given opportunity.

Aim to listen to your child read aloud 3 – 4 times a week and record in the reading record. This provides practise opportunities suited for your child's level and revisits many of the common words.

Reading bands will be assessed based upon the individual child and their progress. Once books have been finished pop it in their reading records and the book can be changed. We aim to check these daily.

ASSESSMENT

Daily assessment is completed and recorded to ensure your child is supported as best they can be. Your child's grades are communicated in grade cards throughout the year. EYFS are assessed on the 17 Early Learning Goals (ELG's). Year 1 will have phonics screening checks from the 14th June. This is to assess their reading and phonic ability of real and alien words.
