Please note that any donations of beer, wine or spirits must be brought to the school office by an adult and not sent into school with your child. Many thanks.

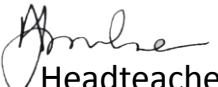
Christmas Fayre – Saturday 2nd December 2017
