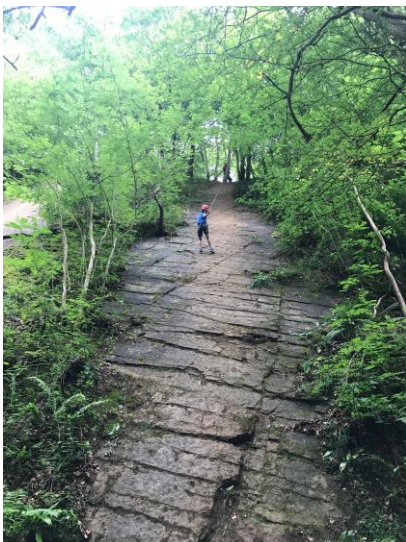




Dear Parents

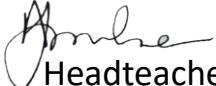
