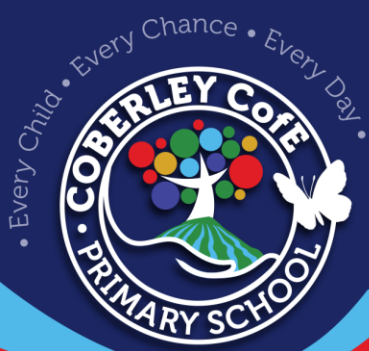

Please make sure you have arrangements in place to ensure your children are collected at 4pm.

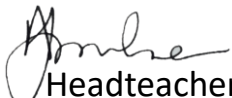
Channel Swim in aid of Gloucestershire Deaf Association
