Class 1 & 2's Trip to We the Curious

Classes 1 and 2 had a fantastic trip to We the Curious in Bristol on Wednesday. There was so much to see and do – our favourites being the artists' area, the building site and the giant hamster wheel! Class 1 took part in a Go Explore workshop, finding out about different habitats from around the world. Class 2 took part in a Destination Space workshop, preparing them as astronauts for a space trip, as well an amazing visit to the 3D planetarium, where they explored the whole solar system in less than half an hour! An amazing day, where the children were fascinated and amazed by all they saw.



Class 3 Anglo Saxon Museum

Class 3 were excited to share their knowledge of the Anglo Saxons this week by setting up their very own museum. They expertly displayed a wide range of artefacts, carrying out research on each one so that visitors could learn more about all the items on show.

Every child in Class 1 and 2 had their very own expert tour guide and were taught about a wide range of aspects of Anglo Saxon life.

Children found out about: Anglo Saxon fashion, including how materials of the time were made and the difference in dress for rich and poor; craft and jewellery, where exhibits featured exquisite brooches, rings, and beads; the Anglo Saxon chatelaine (a grooming instrument), was a particular hit with the children that are fans of CBBC's Horrible Histories programme!

All of Class 3 really enjoyed the experience and learnt a lot through teaching others.

- Clearing away on the day

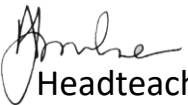
