Writing:

Please complete Task 1 and Task 2 of the writing tasks. Task 1 is to write a set of instructions telling us how you made your UK landmark model. Task 2 is to create an acrostic poem about spring. These tasks can be completed in your purple exercise books – stick the task in at the top of the page.

Maths:

Please complete the Spring 1 maths mats that are in your pack. There are six of these sheets so I suggest you do one or two each day.

Reading:

Please do your normal reading with a grown up or older sibling as often as you can. Please complete the first two comprehension sheets in your booklet.

Spelling:

Practise the first half of the Year 2 or Year 3/4 common exception words from the list. You can use the booklets to help you practise. I suggest you practise 5-10 different words each day.

Times tables:

Continue practising your 2 times tables (Year 2) and your 3 times tables (Year 3). Remember that you can use Doodle Times tables or other apps to help. Could you make a set of cards with times tables questions on one side and the answers on the back to test yourself?

Writing:

Please complete Task 3 and Task 4 of the writing tasks. Task 3 is to write a letter to a family member or friend. Task 4 is to write an Easter story. These tasks can be completed in your purple exercise books – stick the task in at the top of the page.

Maths:

Please complete the Spring 2 maths mats that are in your pack. There are six of these sheets so I suggest you do one or two each day.

Reading:

Please do your normal reading with a grown up or older sibling as often as you can. Please complete the third and fourth sheets in your comprehension booklet.

Spelling:

Practise the second half of the Year 2 or Year 3/4 common exception words from the list. You can use the booklets to help you practise. I suggest you practise 5-10 different words each day.

Times tables:

Continue practising your 5 times tables (Year 2) and your 4 times tables (Year 3). Remember that you can use Doodle Times tables or other apps to help. Could you make some times tables matching pairs cards?
