- Established daily class on-line lessons

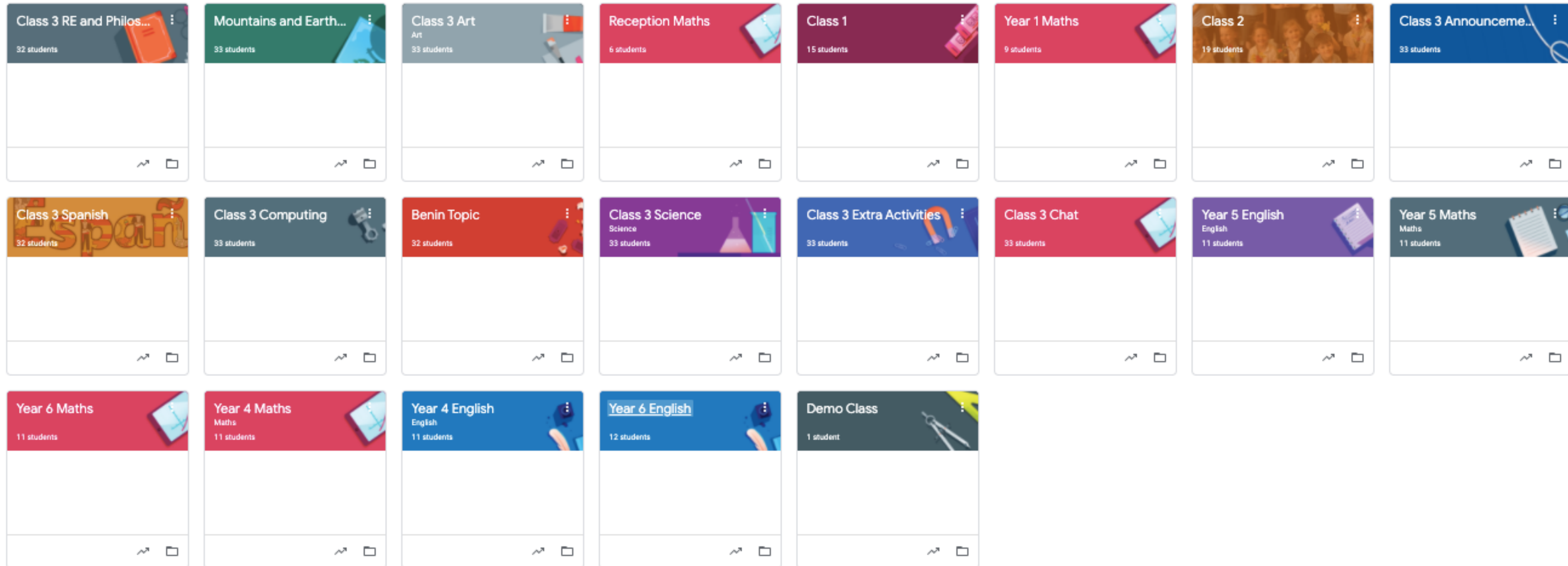

Google Classrooms

- Class 1 & 2 have essentially one class used as an on-line notice board to post comments, links and images
- Class 3 have a classroom for each curriculum area. Class 3 Announcements is used for daily work
